Statement in Support of Sacramento Teachers

Sonoma County— Sunday evening I was informed that no deal had been reached between Sacramento City Unified School District SCUSD and the Sacramento City Teachers Association SCTA. I was further informed that Dolores Huerta would be speaking at Rosemont High, March 28, in support of striking Sacramento teachers.

I believe teachers and families are the stakeholders. School districts and unions exist to support teachers and families. California deserves better. Teachers and families deserve better. Children deserve better.

So, Sunday night I pledged to show up in support of Sacramento teachers the next day at Rosemont High.

Monday, March 28, my team arrived to provide relief services and brought along a whole shopping cart load of water bottles, Gatorades, capri suns and La Croixs to give to teachers.

If the district cannot reach an agreement with the SCTA and Local 1021 SEIU, I plan to stand with and protest alongside Sacramento teachers once again this Thursday, March 31st. I also urge ALL candidates for State Superintendent to speak out in support of the SCTA and Local 1021 SEIU.

Furthermore, I will continue to support Sacramento City Teachers Association teachers—the SCTA, and the Local 1021 SEIU. The district needs to pay, and stop messing around, so families can start sending their children to school again. Over 40,000 children are affected. The strike is reaching day 6.
